❖ **Establishment of the Institution:**

Tura Government College was established on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 1958 to meet the aspirations of the youth of the region for attaining higher education. The college was born out of the far sighted and clear vision of the prominent citizens of Garo Hills for the benefit and future development of its people. Mody K. Marak, Harrison W. Momin, Rangam G. Momin, Ranjit S. Marak, Suresh Das, Dolbir Lohar. Rabibal Jaisi and Mrs. Sodini G. Momin under the patronage of (L) Capt. Williamson A. Sangma, former Chief Minister of Meghalaya were the visionary leaders who founded the college. Provincialised in July 1967 by Govt. of Assam, the college has served its purpose of providing quality higher education for the people of Garo Hills.
