IDP EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction in brief:

Williamnagar Government College (formerly known as Williamnagar College) has been established on 6th May 2000 by the local people of the town with a view to impart higher education to the aspiring local students. It has been provincialized in the year 2009 during the tenure of MPA Government. Presently the college is being run in the Residential School Building of Education Department with a number of classrooms constructed by the then Governing Body of the college in addition to the existing ones. As of now, classrooms are being managed to accommodate the students accordingly. But considering the future enrolment, the college authority had requested the State Government to construct a concrete building in place of old Assam Type structure. In this regard detailed estimate also has been submitted to the competent authority.

The college is situated in a place where there is no other well established college within a radius of nearly 70 kms. This college, ever since its inception, has been catering to the needs of the students of this area. The main objective in establishing this college is to impart quality education to the students in particular and the public in general. Most of the meritorious students of this area come from the financially weak background. Hence, in order to pave way for these meritorious students the college authority approached the Director, CDC, NEHU, Shillong, and the competent authority gave permission and granted Provisional Affiliation to both the Pass and Honours courses since 2001 and 2005 in a phase manner. The subjects taught in this college till date is English, Garo, Political Science, History, Education and Economics.

Regarding the resource persons the State Government has created and sanctioned 30 numbers of posts of Lecturer, 5 (five) posts in each Department, although some posts are yet to be filled up. In the case of non-teaching staff the Government has created one Deputy Librarian, one LDA, one Peon and one Watchman (Night Chawkidar) and filled them accordingly. Considering the student enrolment more staffs are required to address the needs of the students and the official correspondences alike. As far as possible, the Department authority is trying to upgrade the college in terms of infrastructure, library facilities etc., so that the hopes and dreams of the people would fulfil in the near future.

Williamnagar Government College (previously known as Williamnagar College) was started in 2000 (out of the acute necessity of a good educational institution for higher education within the reach of the common people in east garo hills) by the combine effort of the general public, senior citizens, ngo's and student leaders. A governing body consisting of members along with the principal and eight teachers helped it run till 2009 when it was taken over by the government on the 18th February 2009.

The main objective of the institution is to provide all aspiring students to pursue quality education and learn to their fullest potential to become responsible and productive citizens.

The college is located at the centre of Williamnagar town. The college building is complete with office, library, teacher's common room, students' common room and class rooms. The college which is affiliated to the North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong, offers traditional courses in the arts stream under graduate levels both pass and honours. The college has also been provided with examination centre for IGNOU.
